Wash your hands after using the toilet.




Wear hair covers (nets or hats) when handling food.

Simple Present	Affirmative	Negative	Question
I watch TV	I am watch <u>ing</u> TV	I am not watch <u>ing</u> TV	Am I watch <u>ing</u> TV?
Subject + verb	Subject + verb to be + main verb + ing	Subject + verb to be + not + main verb + ing	Verb to be + subject + main verb + ing?



Rules and form

- verbs ending in –e:
 - drop the -e and add -ing.
 - ex: dance dancing
- one syllable verbs (consonant + vowal +consonant)
 - double consonant + -ing.
 - ex: swim swimming
- verbs ending in -ie
 - change to -y + -ing .

```
ex: lie – lying
die - dying
```

Simple Present X Present Continuous

When using adverbs of frequency, we use Simple Present instead of Present Continuous

Adverb of Frequency

100% Always

90% Usually

80% Normally / Generally

Often / Frequently **70**%

Sometimes 50%

Occasionally **30%**

Seldom 10%

Hardly ever / Rarely 5%

Never 0%

I normally exercise.

I am normally exercising.



He hardly ever eats vegetables.

He is hardly ever eating vegetables


