

# Grammar

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*Future with Be + going to - or gonna*



## Pronunciation



In speaking only, we sometimes pronounce *going to* as “*gonna*.” Never write “*gonna*.”



# Grammar

*When we are speaking English, especially fast, we tend to pronounce going to /gonna/. This is very common in every day conversation. Although we pronounce /gonna/, we don't write it because it's informal. Artists have poetic license/artistic license, so it's common to see /gonna/ in songs and movie subtitles.*

<b>you / we / they</b>	You are going to speak.	You are not going to speak.
<b>he / she / it</b>	He is going to speak.	He is not going to speak.
