

WHAT CLASSROOM OBJECTS DO YOU HAVE?


WHAT CLASSROOM OBJECTS DO YOU SEE IN THIS PICTURE?



Singular and Plural Nouns

Spelling Rules for Forming Plural Nouns				
Most plural nouns are formed by adding s:	camera → cameras	pen → pen s		
For nouns ending in a vowel + y add s:	b oy → boys			
<pre>but For nouns ending in a consonant + y, drop the y and add ies:</pre>	dictionary → dictionaries			
For nouns ending in a vowel + o add s:	radio → radios			
but For nouns ending in a <u>consonant</u> + o, add s with some nouns and es with others:	photo → photos	potato → potatoes		
For nouns ending in ch, sh, ss, or x, add es:	class → classes			
For nouns ending in f / fe , change it to $ve + s$:	knife → knives	leaf → leaves		





Articles A/An

ARTICLES: A / AN / THE







• Used for objects that are not specific or one of several things of a similar type

E.g. I need a phone.

. Used the first time we introduce an object

E.g. I saw a movie last night.

• Used as synonyms for the number one

E.g. They bought a computer.

E.g. She is a singer.

• Used to indicate one of a group



• Used before certain adjectives to give a plural meaning

E.g. The rich

• Use for specific objects or objects that both the speaker and listener know

E.g. Can you give me the books on the table?

Used when we mention the object again

E.g. The movie is based on a real-life incident.

 Used before plural countries or other plural regions and bodies of water

E.g. The Netherlands

How many windows are (there) in your bedroom?	There's one. / There are two. / There aren't a		


