

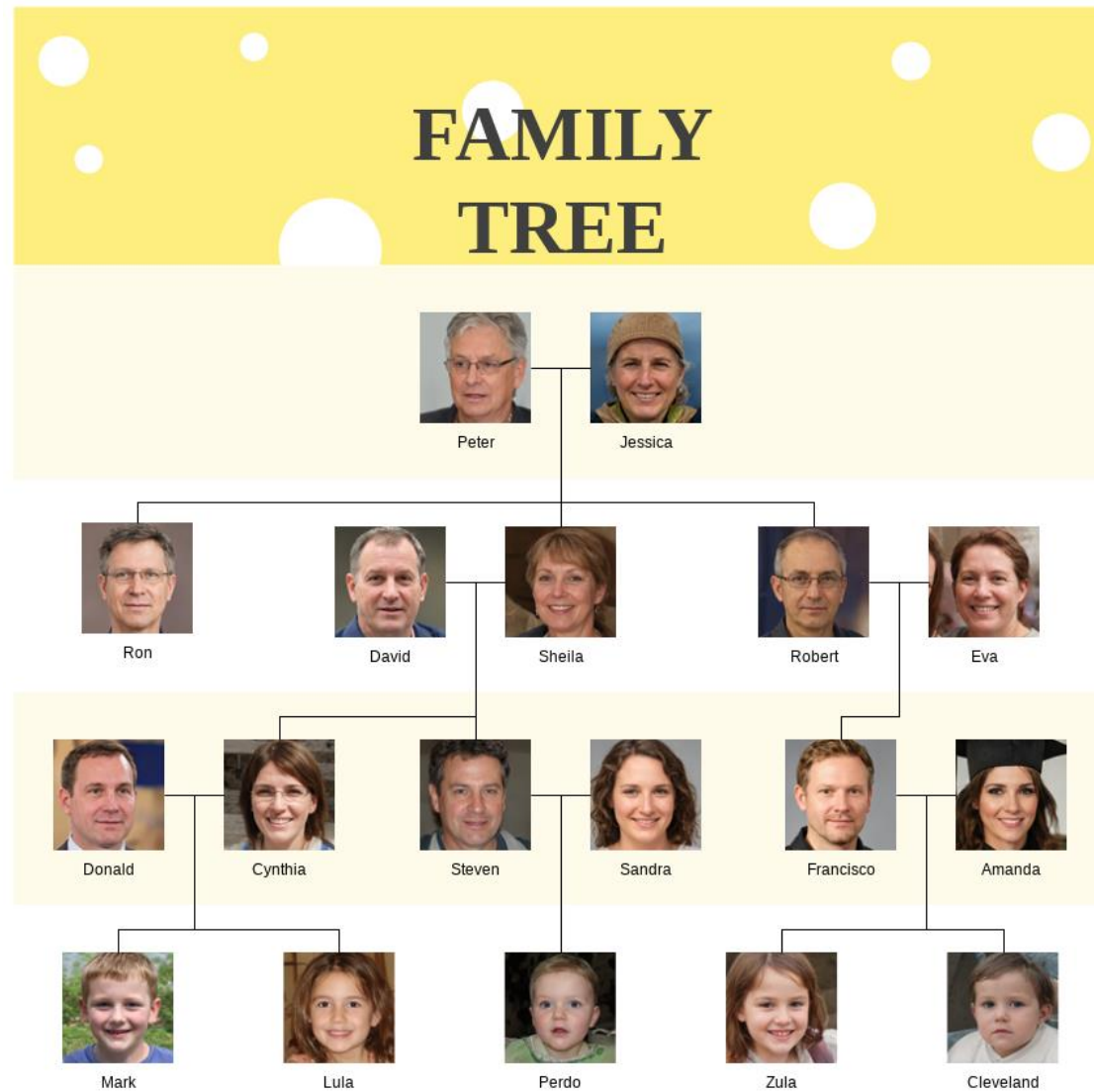

4. How many children are 10 years old?

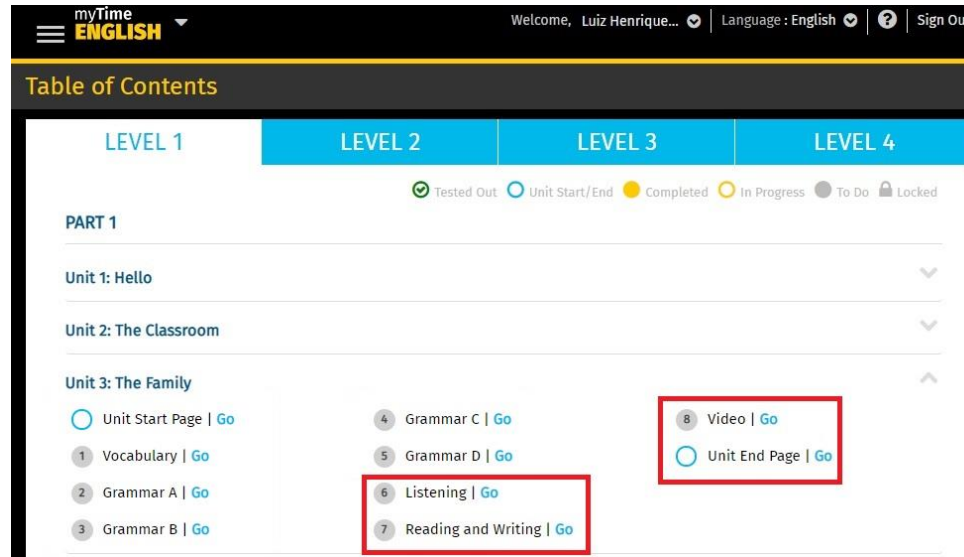
One child is 10 years old.
